Project Title: Building Peace, Safety and Human Rights in Secondary Schools in Badagry Lagos Nigeria

Brief Introduction of the organization and the general content of the granted project

International Society for Peace and Safety, (ISOPS) is a Non-governmental Organization, with a network of individuals in every nook and cranny of Nigeria. The organization was founded in 2012 and registered in Nigeria in 2015 with **(CAC No 78612)** to assist in restoring peace, safety and human rights in Nigeria and worldwide.

Our Vision: is to help create a world in which all humanity will live together in peace, prosperity through non-violence means.

Our Mission: is to spread the work of peace, safety and human rights through education, training, and an enlightenment program with network of individuals and organizations with like minds.

The project selected 56 teachers through the partnership of Nigeria Union of Teachers Badagry branch from 28 schools in Badagry district of Lagos State Nigeria and trained them in peace, safety and human rights. The trained teachers in turns will implement the programs in their various schools.

The project selected 56 teachers and 12 executives and trained them with peace, safety and human rights

21 schools have been reached with our peace, safety and human rights programs with 200 students trained per school with total number of 5,268 reach so far

Total number 306 attended the world peace, safety and human rights day events that award peace and human rights ambassador to 21 students that will be representing their schools as peace builders and human rights advocates to create a world where humanity will live in peace.

We are extending the programs to more schools, which is creating network of young people to connect and work for peace in themselves, their community and in the world
