About organization and granted activity

Harapan Taheta Foundation established at 13 August 2016 by vision: “making a professional, strong, and self-reliance organization in health sector that oriented towards the welfare of people of Central Kalimantan”. Main activities of foundation are education, training and advocacy on health especially sexual and reproductive health rights, HIV-AIDS, rights of PLWHA and transgender, and also community empowerment activity especially in health and economic sector. 2. Done activity by NPF Grant * Within 1000 characters

a) Interfaith Audience was conducted in Palangka Raya at 2 May 2019 attended by religious leaders of Islam, Christian, Catholic, Hindu and Buddha. It was also involved AIDS Commission and Religious Harmony Forum of Central Kalimantan Province; b) Interfaith Public Discussion was conducted 25 July 2019 in Palangka Raya attended by 5 religious leaders and several his congregates, religion school administrators and other institution that concerned with issues of stigma and discrimination against PLWHA; c) Workshop on Reducing the Impact of Stigma and Discrimination with PLWHA was conducted 25-26 September 2019 in Palangka Raya attended by 5 religion institution leaders/board members; d) Special/Executive Event through Commemoration of World AIDS Day in 2019 was conducted at December 1st, 2019. The activity was involved religious leaders, pilgrim representatives from 5 religion and youth representatives from schools and universities for peaceful action took to the streets voiced: “remove stigma and discrimination against PLWHA”.

3. Output or Outcome * Within 1000 characters

Output of program: a) It has been held Interfaith Audience attended 12 participants from 5 religions and related stakeholder (AIDS Commission and Religion Harmony Forum of Central Kalimantan Province); b) It has been held Interfaith Public Discussion attended 70 participants (religion leaders, religion school administrators, and others institution representatives); c) It has been held Workshop on Reducing the Impact of Stigma and Discrimination to PLWHA attended 45 participants (leaders and members of 5 religion institutions); d) It has been held Special Event - Commemoration of World AIDS Day 2019 involved 500 participants (religion leaders, congregates members from 5 religions and students from schools and universities).

Outcome of program: a) Increasing of knowledge and understanding of religion leaders on HIV-AIDS; b) Religion leaders were skilled in providing information on HIV-AIDS to their congregations and community; c) Increasing of knowledge on HIV-AIDS of religious congregates and communities; d) There are awareness and emphyaty of religious congregates and communities about negative impact of stigma and discrimination on PLWHA.
